Full payment is due by February 27. **Cancellation policy:** Through February 27, all but \$50 will be refunded. No refunds after February 27. **Housing preferences:** first come, first serve.

Housing: We use a tiered housing price structure. We prioritize housing requests by registration receipt date. Housing assignments will be given out upon arrival to the weekend.

Adult registrants will need to select from 3 tiers of room options. (Youth can room with adults in any room tier. There is no price differential for youth registrants.)

Tier 1:

Private room with private or semi-private bath, sleeps 2 to 6 people depending on room. **\$250 per adult**

Tier 2:

Semi-private room within a larger complex, shared bathrooms. **\$235 per adult**

Tier 3:

Dormitory style room, shared bathrooms, OR Rustic Cabin (must use bathrooms in main lodge) **\$220 per adult**

An example of Tier 1 room would be Northern Pacific, Wadena; an example of Tier 2 is the Refuge, Birds Nest; an example of Tier 3 is the Brandt loft, or Lappland, Room 2. - Folks are welcome to stay Thursday night **if arranged in advance of the weekend with Maplelag**. The extra nights must be arranged and paid for directly through Maplelag. Maplelag will work with the Cloggers, and we'll notify you of room assignments for Thursday night.
